




steering damper Road & Track






steering damper MX

shock absorber Road & Track






The part number is on the "head" of the shock, the production number on the opposite side.




front fork Road & Track






The part number is on the inside of the fork bottom.


Universal front fork






The part number is under the fork bottom.

Catridge Kit Road & Track






The part number is on the top cap.

For MX & Enduro cartridge kits the part number is on the cylinder tube of the cartridge. It can't be seen when mounted, therefore just mention the brand and bike model. Best case you send the complete front fork for service.

Road & Track shock absorber car





The part number on a sticker at the bottom of the shock absorber. It is always the number of the single shock, one number is enough to mention. Please tick the boxes near to the drawing which shocks you will send in for service.
