Raise the vehicle and put it on jack stands.

Ensure that is is securely supported.

Remove the front wheels.

3

Remove the stabilizer links and brake hose brackets from the standard struts.

4

Loosen the bolts for the lower strut attachments.

Caution!

Support the wheel hubs in an appropriate way on each side of the vehicle so that the brake hoses can not be damaged.

5

Loosen the upper attachments. Remove the original struts from the car.




Tighten the lower spring seat and the lock nut to 50 - 60 Nm.


Fit the dust boot, the spring and the upper spring seat to the strut according to fig 1 Fit the standard lower bearing spacer, the standard top mount and the standard top nut. Tighten the top nut to 35 - 40 Nm.

Install the Öhlins McPherson struts on the vehicle according to fig 2.

Mount the standard stabilizer links and standard brake hose brackets to the Öhlins struts according to fig 3. Tighten the nut to 6 Nm.

Note!

When tightening the top mount nut, the shock absorber shaft must be held in position with a 5 mm Allen key.

Fasten the upper attachments.

10

Raise the wheel hub with a jack to remove the freeplay of the lower strut attachment bolts before tightening them.

Note!

Make sure that all bolts are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the strut when it is being fully compressed or extended. Test this over the whole steering range from lock to lock.



Make sure that all removed parts are reinstalled in the same way as they were before the installation of the Öhlins shock absorber. 3

Caution!

Assemble this washer. The brake hose bracket is not correctly fixed without it.

ADJUSTMENTS

▲ Warning!

The standard preload is 7 mm from a free length of 200 mm, giving 193 mm installed length, see fig 6.

The actual vehicle height

With both the preload and height adjustments in their standard positions, the vehicle is lowered approximately 20 mm when compared to the original suspension. As the height adjuster is turned one rotation, the position moves 2.0 mm.


The adjustment range is the standard position -3 to +15 mm.



Raise the vehicle and put it on jack stands.

Remove the rear wheels.

3

Remove the lower and the upper attachments and remove the original shock absorbers.

4

Remove the spring.

5

Set the spring seat of the spring height adjuster to the position according to fig 4 and 6.

6

Remove the OEM upper spring cup according to figure 2.

7

Install the Öhlins spring, the spring height adjuster, the rubber seats and the plastic seat on the vehicle according to fig 4.


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
Fit the dust boot, the std rubber bushes, the std washer and adjuster according to fig 1 Tighten the lock nut to 20 Nm.


The std nut must be removed from the std bush according to fig 3.

Note!

When tightening the lower mount nut, the shock absorber shaft must be held in position with a 5 mm spanner.

Install the Öhlins shock absorbers on the vehicle.

Fasten the upper attachments.

Note!

Make sure that all bolts are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when it is being fully compressed or extended.

Make sure that all removed parts are reinstalled in the same way as they were before the installation of the Öhlins shock absorber.

Sub-assemble the wire.


(Fasten the adjustment knob by tightening the M4 screw.)


As shown in fig 5, insert the wire through the Ø10 hole which is made in the side panel, and run it inside the panel.

Insert the top end of the wire into the adjuster and fasten it with the supplied Allen key.



Set the spring height adjuster, the spring seat, the lock ring, the rubber seats and the plastic seat to the fitting in the figure below.

With the height adjustments in their standard positions, the vehicle is lowered approximately 25 mm when compared to the original suspension. As the height adjuster is turned one rotation, the position moves 1.5 mm.

The adjustment range is the standard position ±15 mm. If the spring height adjuster is moved outside the adjustment range, the spring might drop out.
