



Install the dust boot (2), the plastic spring spacer (3), the spring (4), the rubber spring spacer (5), the upper spring seat (6), the bearing (7), the adapter ring (8) and the spacer (9) to the strut according to fig 2. Install the standard top mount, the washer (10) and the lock nut M14 (11).





Tighten the lock nut to 35 - 40 Nm.

Set the spring preload by adjusting the spring preload adjuster according to fig 3. Tighten the lock ring to 50-60Nm.

Install the Öhlins McPherson struts on the vehicle.

Fasten the upper attachments.

Raise the wheel hub with a jack to remove the freeplay of the lower strut attachment bolts before tightening them.
