Note!

Before you install this product clean the vehicle.

1

Put the motorcycle on a work stand so that the rear wheel is up in the air and put a support under the rear wheel.

2

Refer to the manufacturer's user manual and carry out measures to lift the subframe slightly. This allows the original shock absorber to be removed.

3

Remove the lower shock absorber screw.

4

Remove the upper shock absorber screw. Lower the swing arm and remove the shock absorber.

5

Mount the Öhlins shock absorber in reverse order.

6


Using the original screws, mount the hydraulic preload master cylinder on the inside of the fotpeg mount.

7

Use supplied Tie-raps (00231-01) to fasten the hose.

8

Before riding the bike, check that all screws are tightened correctly and that there are no clearance issues when the rear suspension is moving.


