
# **Adjustments**





# How to Install

## **▲** Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.


When installing, read the Vehicle Service Manual.

1

Put the motorcycle on a workstand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground. The swing arm must be free so that the suspension is unloaded.

## **▲** Warning!

Make sure the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.



2

Remove the seats and the side covers.

### 3

Remove the bolts for the upper and lower attachments and remove the original shock absorber.

4

Install the Öhlins shock absorber in the same way as the original unit, do not tighten yet.

### • Note!

Lower the motorcycle so that the shock absorber is sligthly compressed, before tightening the screws.

#### 10

Reinstall the seats. Make sure that all removed parts are reinstalled in the same way as they were before the installation.

# **<sup>™</sup>** Caution!

Make sure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.
