



1. Remove the engine front guard by removing the screws (1234)



Remove the engine bottom guard by removing the screws 1






Remove the seat by removing the bolts (1)


On LH side and RH side :


Remove the plastic cover by loosening the screw (1). Loosen the nut (2) located underneath the cover





9.2 Remove the sprocket cover by loosening the screws (1) (2)




9.3 Remove the evap canister bracket by loosening the screws (1)

Install the Öhlins shock absorber with the hose pointing to the left side of the motorcycle. Tighten the upper ① and the lower mounting bolts ② and ③ at a torque value as specified in the vehicle service manual.



Note!

Lower the vehicle so that the suspension is slightly compressed before tightening the screws.

Caution!

Ensure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.




Rout the reservoir to the left side of the motorcycle as per diagram P1 12. Adjust the reservoir and hose position so

that the hose is not touching any motorcycle parts.

Reverse all procedures as necessary




